

## **ABSTRACT**

**ACCORDING TO THE MODEL OF CLINICAL SUPERVISION, THE TEACHERS' THOUGHTS, RELATED TO THE BEHAVIOURS WHICH MUST BE SHOWN AND HAVE BEEN SHOWN BY THE CHAIRMEN OF THE DEPARTMENTS OF MILITARY HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE ARMY**

In this research it is aimed to determine the teachers' thoughts related to the behaviours which must be shown and have been shown by the chairmen of the departments of the military high schools in the army. 140 teachers, out of a total 220, have been sampled from the target population. "Clinical Supervision Questionnaire", developed by the researcher, was applied for the teachers who were in the sample group. The obtained data have been analyzed with SPSS 10.0 software. The following are the important findings of this research:

All of the teachers have expressed that planning conference, observation and feedback conference stages should "always" be applied by the chairmen of the departments.

With respect to the teachers' ranks and departments, there are significant difference among teachers' thoughts related to the behaviours which must be shown and have been shown by the chairmen of the departments of the military high schools in the army. But there are no significant difference among practical lessons teachers' thoughts related to the behaviours which must be shown and have been shown by the chairmen of the departments of the military high schools in the army.
